SEWER AND WATER LATERALS

Did you know that YOU, as a homeowner, has a responsibility with maintaining the sewer and water systems?

Homeowners are required to maintain the laterals from their home. Maintaining the lateral includes keeping the lateral line flowing and free of debris such as roots, or grease.

Sewer backups can cause tremendous damage to the interior of a home. In order to minimize these, Delta City provides continual maintenance services for the public sewer mainlines. Unfortunately, laterals are often not maintained by private property owners until a disaster strikes. It is our hope that we can provide you various means of addressing these issues and thus minimize your risk of an overflow entering your home:

- 1-Maintain your lateral through proper cleaning, repair, and replacement 2-Do not place improper items into the sewer or make improper connections to the sewer
 - Keep rainwater out of the sewer lines as it overwhelms the capacity of the sewer lines and may cause sewer spills.
 - b. Do not pour fats, oils, and grease in your drains as these products harden and stick to the inside of the sewer pipes, which build up and may eventually cause a blockage in the sewer pipe.

Taking these simple steps can help keep the flow going, and prevent costly overflows and damage.

DID YOU KNOW...

The trash containers in the park have been provided for the use of park visitors to help keep the park clean. Residents should not use these containers for disposal of their household garbage. Personal garbage may be dropped off at any of Millard County's collection locations or home pick up can be arranged with through a local collection agency.
