WINTER PARKING

No parking on city streets or paved right-of-ways November 1st-March 31st to allow for snow removal.

Property owners are responsible for their own snow removal. It is illegal to move snow, leaves and other yard waste onto City streets and right of ways.

LICENSE RENEWALS

Business license:

Renewals are due December 31st. All activity for economic gain within city limits are required to be licensed. Contact the City Office for more information.

Animal license:

Renewals are due February 1st. All dogs over 6 months of age are required to be licensed. Proof of rabies vaccinations are required. Watch for renewal notices in the mail next month.

BUILDING VIOLATIONS

We are still having problems with residents building without obtaining the appropriate permits. Before you construct, remodel, or build anything on your property you should contact the City Office to find out what permits, setbacks, and requirements you need. Failure to do so could be very costly.

DID YOU KNOW...

You can take precautions now to prevent problems caused by cold weather.

- Adjust thermostats and/or keep a small stream running in a faucet to keep pipes from freezing.
- Clean Chimneys and keep them clear from debris.
- Install and or check Carbon Monoxide detectors.
- Remember to keep your pets warm.
