Building, Chickens, Conditional Use, Fencing, Parking, Sign, Special Events. Permits are issued on a per occurrence basis.

### Licenses are required for:

Dogs, Business, Kennels. Licenses are renewable.

## GARBAGE REMINDER

As weather warms up, so have the neighbor complaints about garbage not being property contained, being smelly and/or attracting cats, mice and other critters. To help keep your neighbors happy, please do not store garbage in your yard or in open vehicles.  
10-414a "All Garbage and refuse shall be placed in suitable and sufficient garbage receptacles, either receptacles with tight fitting lids or properly and sufficiently treated water resistant bags manufactured specifically for use in garbage and refuse collection."  
10-415 "All garbage and market waste must be placed in rainproof, fly proof receptacles of the type herein required and receptacles shall be tightly closed in such a manner as to prevent offensive odors or flies."  
See code 10-413, 414 & 415 for complete details.

## GREEN WASTE SITE

Due to circumstances beyond our control, the area that Delta City allowed dumping of grass clippings and limbs, just north of the county's waste collection site, will remain closed.
