WEEDS & DELETERIOUS OBJECTS

We ask residents and property owners to be mindful of their yards, and keep them clear of weeds and deleterious objects. Preferably before your neighbors call to complain and/or we have to send a violation notice.

WATERING

If your sprinkling system has a water budgeting option, it's time to start using it! You can also reduce water use manually.

PENALTY RATE CHANGE

To equalize the liability, the penalty rate for utilities and other city services will be changing from \$5 to 5%, reflective on next month's bill.

ANIMAL LICENSING

The animal license annual expiration date will be changing from February 1st to July 1st, allowing 4 extra months this year. This will coincide with our animal control contract and allow us more opportunities for vaccination clinics.
