DID YOU KNOW...

The speed limit on all unposted streets is 25 MPH. You'll note that this is case on most City streets.

Please help us keep things safe by following the speed limit regardless of how wide or smooth the road may be or how cool your car sounds accelerating.

WINTER PARKING

No parking on city streets or paved right-of-way's November 1st-March 31st to allow for snow removal.

WINTER WEATHER REMINDERS

-Please use caution around plows. They are big, heavy, and require a lot of space to maneuver and extra time to stop. Please stay back and give them plenty of room to work.

- Leaving garbage cans on the street will also prevent plows from removing snow on your street.

-When driving in winter conditions, know you and your vehicle's limits, be alert and allow extra travel time.

-Business owners and homeowners are responsible for clearing sidewalks, parking, and drives.

-It is best to shovel driveways to the sides. Anything pushed into the street is likely to end up back in the driveway or sidewalk when a plow comes by.

-During cold weather, it's important to keep pets fed and warm. We have had an increase of pets running at large, possibly seeking food and/or shelter.
