Licenses are required for: Dogs and Businesses. Licenses are renewable.

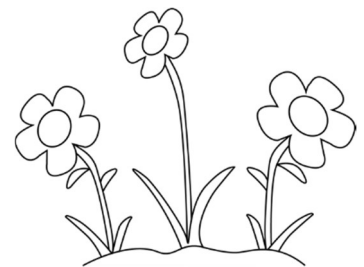
