## RULES FOR BURNING

**-Contact Sheriff's Office at 435-864-2755**

-No burning household trash, garbage, plastics, coated wires, oils, hazardous materials & other such materials

-No burning in areas that would threaten shrubs or dry grasses

-No burning during periods of high wind, posted fire restriction periods, during red flag warnings, etc.

-No burning within 50' of buildings and structures

-Burn only materials that are dry and reasonably free of dirt

-Have adequate water supply on site or other means to extinguish or contain fire from spreading

-Create adequate fuel break at 2.5 times the height of the fire.

-Notify your neighbors

-A competent person must attend the fire at all times and all fires must be completely extinguished before dark or leaving the area. **YOU ARE RESPONSIBLE FOR ANYTHING YOUR FIRE OR ITS SMOKE DOES.**
