RULES FOR BURNING

-Contact Sheriff's Office at 435-864-2755-No burning household trash, garbage, plastics, coated wires, oils, hazardous materials & other such materials

-No burning in areas that would threaten shrubs or dry grasses -No burning during periods of high wind, posted fire restriction periods, during red flag warnings, etc.

-No burning within 50' of buildings and structures -Burn only materials that are dry and reasonably free of dirt

-Have adequate water supply on site or other means to extinguish or contain fire from spreading

-Create adequate fuel break at 2.5 times the height of the fire.

-Notify your neighbors -A competent person must attend the fire at all times and all fires must be completely extinguished before dark or leaving the area. YOU ARE RESPONSIBLE FOR ANYTHING YOUR FIRE OR ITS SMOKE DOES.
