The Delta City Library will be hosting four art exhibits/shows: September is the WWI art exhibit, October Vietnam Combat Veterans, February 2018 will be the high school art show and March 2018 will be Go Out and Play. Each exhibit will be displayed for approximately one month.

Summer Story Hour

Librarian Greathouse reported that the summer reading hour was a huge success! By utilizing the brain flakes the library could accurately track books read and pages read. The following are the total break down for each age group, 3-5-year-old had 206 attend and 1785 books read. 6-9-year-old had 151 attend, 1106 books read and 5055 minutes of total reading time. The 10-12-year-old had 23 attend, 83 books and 4880 minutes of total reading time.
