Mayor Bunker called the meeting to order at 7:00 p.m. He stated that notice of the time, place and the agenda of the meeting had been posted at the City Building, on the Utah Public Notice website, the Delta City website, and had been provided to the Millard County Chronicle-Progress and to each member of the City Council at least two days prior to the meeting.

Opening remarks were provided by Council Member Banks, following which Mayor Bunker led those in attendance in the Pledge of Allegiance.

MINUTES

The minutes of the regular City Council meeting held November 06, 2014 were presented for approval. Following a discussion, Council Member Betty Jo Western MOTIONED to adopt the minutes of the regular meeting held November 06, 2014 as presented. The motion was SECONDED by Council Member John Niles. Mayor Bunker asked if there were any questions or comments regarding the motion. There being none, he called for a vote. The motion passed with Council Member Robert Banks, Council Member John Niles, Council Member Betty Jo Western and Council Member Steven Pratt voting in favor, and Council Member Kiley Chase being absent.

ACCOUNTS PAYABLE

The Council reviewed the accounts payables and the electronic transactions for the period ending November 20, 2014 in the amount of \$68,202.47, copies of which had been provided to them at least two days prior to the meeting. Following a discussion Council Member Robert Banks MOVED to approve the accounts payables and electronic transactions for November 20, 2014 in the amount of \$68,202.47 as presented. The motion was SECONDED by Council Member Betty Jo Western. Mayor Bunker asked if there were any questions or comments regarding the motion. There being none, he called for a vote. The motion passed with Council Member Robert Banks, Council Member John Niles, Council Member Betty Jo Western and Council Member Steven Pratt voting in favor, and Council Member Kiley Chase being absent.

PUBLIC COMMENT PERIOD

There were no comments from the public.

BUSINESS

Millard County Sheriff's Office Update

Lieutenant Morris Burton with Millard County Sheriff's Office gave an update on Law Enforcement activity within Delta City. Lt. Burton reported 911 calls, citations cited, Accident Reports and Incident Reports by nature. Lt. Burton also reported on the number and the nature of arrests within Delta City. Mayor Bunker asked if the speed trailer could be moved around the city more often. Lt. Burton responded to this, explaining how the speed trailer is managed. Council Member Steven Pratt reported to Lt. Burton regarding a community member that had speed issues. Lt. Burton discussed speed and also noise issues with the Council. Council Betty Jo Western stated that she had noticed children trying to cross streets outside of the cross walks. Lt. Morris cited cross walk regulations for the Council. Mayor Bunker thanked the Millard County Sheriff Office Deputies and employees for their hard work.

Proposed Resolution 14-380 Adopting Delta City Water Conservation Plan

Mayor Bunker presented the proposed Resolution 14-380 adopting Delta City Water Conservation Plan. Council Member Steven Pratt MOVED to approve Resolution 14-380 adopting Delta City Water Conservation Plan. Council Member Robert Banks SECONDED the motion. Mayor Bunker asked if there were any questions or comments regarding the motion. There being none, he called for a vote. The motion passed with Council Member Robert Banks, Council Member John Niles, Council Member Betty Jo Western and Council Member Steven Pratt voting in favor, and Council Member Kiley Chase being absent.

Light Parade, New Year's Eve Celebration

Mayor Bunker and the Council discussed updated activities for the Light Parade and Santa's appearance, as well as the Festival of the Trees. Council Member Betty Jo Western verified that the City wanted Laurie Griffiths to decorate the stage area where Santa sits. Mayor Bunker stated that City Employees had decorated two trees for the festival, and were stuffing candy bags on Tuesday. The Council then discussed New Year's Eve celebration plans. Council Member Betty Jo Western discussed the entertainment for the evening. Mayor Bunker verified that there would be a ball drop with the City Employees, and that the fireworks were ordered. The food for New Year's Eve was discussed briefly.

Public Works Update

Asst. Public Works Director Dent Kirkland updated the Council on Public Works projects. Mr. Kirkland reported on the fall clean-up. Mr. Kirkland stated that the Delta City Crew had been very busy getting Christmas decorations up. Mr. Kirkland also reported on a water leak that occurred in Delta Estates. A training from the Drinking Water Board transpired, Mr. Kirkland related, as well as some water meter work. Asst. Public Works Director Dent Kirkland gave details on the new two way water meter program that Delta would be using. City Attorney Todd Anderson asked if the City had given any notice for a reminder on the Delta City Parking/Snow Removal Ordinance. Mr. Kirkland verified that there had been notice given on the water bills and on the Delta City Web site. There was a discussion regarding the chlorine in the water.

OTHER BUSINESS

Mayor Bunker informed the Council that the Mayor from the Town of Hinckley had called him regarding the loss of an employee and the need to get water samples done. Mayor Bunker stated that he instructed Delta employees to get the samples needed for the Town of Hinckley, and Delta City would charge them as per the fee schedule for man hours. Hinckley is in the process of hiring to fill the job vacancy. The Airport Development Group will be giving an update in January regarding the Airport Master Plan. Mayor Bunker reported that Judge Stan Robison was retiring effective April 1st, 2015. Mayor Bunker described several options that could be considered regarding the Justice Court that the Mayor wanted the Council to be thinking about. The Council suggested doing something for Judge Robison for his service to the city. There was a discussion on the Un-plugged program and the brag-tags. Mayor Bunker reminded the Council about the Delta City Christmas dinner on December 5th at 6:30 pm at the Community Center. Mayor Bunker reported to the Council on the intent to put a sink and counter/cabinets in the break room in the city building. Council Member Betty Jo Western thanked the City Employees for the excellent job on the Delta City Clean-up, and how nice it was that Delta City provided this service. The cost to decorate for Christmas was discussed. It was brought up that Delta City makes most of the decorations saving a lot of money. Mayor Bunker briefly discussed the SCAOG Regional Hazard Assessment Meeting coming up on December 4th. The Council suggested sending a delegate to represent Delta City.

Mayor Bunker asked if there were any comment, questions, or other items to be discussed. There being none, Council Member Betty Jo Western MOVED to adjourn the regular City

Council meeting. Council Member Robert Banks SECONDED the motion. The motion passed with Council Member Robert Banks, Council Member John Niles, Council Member Betty Jo Western and Council Member Steven Pratt voting in favor, and Council Member Kiley Chase being absent.

Mayor Bunker declared the meeting adjourned at 8:10 p.m.
