MINUTES

UNFINISHED BUSINESS

There were no matters of unfinished business on the agenda.

BUSINESS

AUTHOR VISIT

The topic of our guest speaker, author J. Scott Savage, was discussed. He is scheduled to be at Delta Middle School in the morning and at Delta City Library on October 29 at 7:00 p.m. Upcoming potential authors and illustrators were discussed.

BOOKPACKS

The board discussed the situation with the book packs. One book pack has been checked out. These are geared mostly to 7th and 8th graders to help encourage reading skills

SCHOOL

Colleen Atkinson, an 8th grade teacher, takes her reading class to the library once a month for a class activity. This will continue throughout the school year. Lisa Draper also a teacher brought two of her classes to the library to learn how to download e-books.

NEWSPAPER DIGITIZATION GRANT

The board discussed the grant of \$7400.00 which was used this year to digitize the Millard County Chronicle issues from 1910 – 1947. With the board's approval the library trust fund will be used to digitize five additional years of the Millard County Chronicle at the cost of approximately \$4500.00.

ART SHOW

An art exhibit featuring Native American pictures and biographies will be at the library until November 25. The library plans to display artwork by Delta High School students in the spring.

LIBRARY LEGO CLUB

The Library Lego Club which is led by Daniel Gale was discussed and evaluated. Attendance has been down but will keep the program active until further discussion. Books are read at the beginning and then the attendees have a theme in which to build a creation.

TEEN BOOK CLUB

The first meeting of the Teen Book Club was on September 4, 2014 at 3:00 p.m. Michelle Lovejoy leads this activity. The First book read was The Giver and the second Divergent.

LIBRARY ACTIVITIES

The board discussed possible ways to use the solar and wind power kits which were acquired by the library. They could be used by an after school program called the DYAC which is led by Darla Ewart. Jody suggested that the kits could be used as a demonstration at a Cub Scout pack meeting. Mr. Chad Warnick, who leads the high school Lego Robotics Club, or Daniel Gale who may possibly lead the 4-H Lego Robotics Club, could use the kits.

The next library board meeting will be on January 13, 2014.

There being no other business, Librarian Greathouse asked if there were any comments, questions, or other items to be discussed. There being none, Board Member Jody Smith MOVED
