

The Mayor and each Councilman studied the Budget FY 78-79 as prepared on state forms by Robison Hill and Company, which included the Proposed Use of Revenue Sharing and anticipated expenditures as per Revenue Sharing Regulations.

No interested parties appeared for the purpose of objecting to, or approving the adoption of said budget so Councilman Callister made a motion to adopt the budget for the fiscal year beginning July 1, 1978 and ending June 30, 1979. The next order of business to come before Council was the resignation of Lilli Dawson as City Recorder and her reappointment, by the Mayor, as City Treasurer on June 29th, 1978. Also the resignation of Dorothy Jeffery as City Treasurer and her reappointment, by the Mayor, as City Recorder on June 29th, 1978.

The Mayor explained to Council that these reappointments had to be made because the duties of each of these two employees have been in conflict with the State Statute requirements and must be corrected in order to conform and be legal. All Councilmen present were in agreement.

There being no further business Councilman Callister made a motion to adjourn at 9:30 p.m. His motion was seconded by Councilman Losee.
