Mayor Roper being present called the meeting to order at 7:00 p.m. Dorothy Jeffery being present acted as secretary.

Mayor Roper said that notice of the time, place and purpose of the meeting had been duly advertised in the Millard County Chronicled and notice was sent to each member of the governing body.

Mayor Roper stated that the meeting was a Public Hearing for the purpose of receiving and considering public comment on the amending of the 1979-80 budget and to the adoption of the proposed budget FY 1980-81.

Dick Turner, Accountant for Robison/Hill Company explained to those in attendance at the meeting the amendments being made to the 1979-80 budget. Copies of the amended budget are on file in the office of the City Recorder.

The Mayor and each Councilman studied the Budget FY 1980-81 as prepared on State forms by Robison/Hill and Company which included the Proposed Use Of Revenue Sharing and anticipated expenditures as per Revenue Sharing regulations.

There was a general discussion of the expenditures and revenues for the 1980-81 budget year. Mr. Turner explained in detail the need to consider increasing the mill levy by four (4) mills to cover the anticipated expenditures.

There being no further business Councilman Bennett MOVED to

adjourn at 7:28 p.m. His MOTION was seconded by Councilman Morrison. Meeting adjourned.
