Mayor Dafoe called the Public Hearing to order at 6:30 p.m. Dorothy Jeffery, City Recorder, acted as secretary. Mayor Dafoe stated that notice of the meeting time, place and agenda was posted at the principal office of the governing body located at 76 North 200 West and was provided to the Millard County Chronicle/Progress, the local radio station, KNAK, and to each member of the City Council by personal delivery two days prior to the meeting.

Mayor Dafoe stated that the purpose of the Public Hearing was to receive public comment regarding the proposed Delta City Annual Budget for Fiscal year 1990-1991.

Mayor Dafoe explained that one year ago when the 1989-1990 Budget was prepared, the City Council agreed that it would be advantageous to the citizens if the Library were to have an independent taxing ability. However, after working with the budget over the past year, it is the decision of the City Council that it is in the best interest of the citizens of Delta to delete the special Library Tax and return the Library funding to the General Fund of the City. Therefore, the notice of tax increase does not require an actual increase in property taxes.

Mrs. Edith Anderson asked questions regarding the funding of the Delta City Fire Department. Mayor Dafoe explained that the Delta City Fire Department is not funded by Delta City's General Fund. The Fire Department is funded by the Millard County Fire District but Delta City administers those funds.

There was no opposition to the proposed Budget for Fiscal Year 1990-1991 expressed.
