Mayor Dafoe called the meeting to order at 5:00 p.m. Dorothy Jeffery, City Recorder, acted as secretary. Mayor Dafoe stated that notice of the meeting time, place and agenda was posted at the principal office of the governing body located at 76 North 200 West and was provided to the Millard County Chronicle/Progress, KNAK Radio Station, and to each member of the City Council by personal delivery two days prior to the meeting.

Mayor Dafoe said that the Six County AOG recently announced the possibility of additional funding through the Community Development Block Grant Program for FY 93-94. The funding is for construction type projects and must be supported by a city, county or regional government and must benefit low and moderate income people within the Six County Region.

Mayor Dafoe explained that the application submitted to the Six County AOG, requested funding to complete a fill stabilization project on the overpass, which would encompass the sides of the overpass. Also included in the application, funding was requested to complete the storm drain sewer system from Main Street to 400 South on 100 West. The approximate cost of the overpass project was \$30,000 and \$91,540 for the storm drain project.

Mayor Dafoe then read a letter he received from Six County Association of Governments regarding the CDBG applicants for stimulus funds which stated that President Clinton's stimulus package was defeated; therefore, the CDBG stimulus funds would not be available.

Mayor Dafoe asked for public comment, questions or items to be discussed. There being none, Mayor Dafoe declared the meeting adjourned at 5:15 p.m.
