Mayor Dafoe called the meeting to order at 6:30 p.m. Dorothy Jeffery, City Recorder, acted as secretary. Mayor Dafoe stated that notice of the meeting time, place and agenda was posted at the principal office of the governing body located at 76 North 200 West and was provided to the Millard County Chronicle/Progress, KNAK Radio Station, and to each member of the City Council by personal delivery two days prior to the meeting.


Mayor Dafoe explained that the purpose of the Public Hearing was to receive public comment regarding a proposed ordinance entitled:

AN ORDINANCE OF THE CITY COUNCIL OF DELTA, UTAH AMENDING THE APPENDIX TO THE RURAL RESIDENTIAL ZONE TO INCORPORATE CERTAIN QUALIFYING REGULATIONS AN SPECIAL CONDITIONS FOR KEEPING ANIMALS AND FOWL FOR PERSONAL USE OR FAMILY FOOD PRODUCTION (NOT FOR COMMERCIAL USE) AS A CONDITIONAL USE.


Mayor Dafoe then asked for comments from those in attendance.

Kurt & Linda Sorensen explained that they have recently bought seven acres within the City limits that is currently zoned A1. This zone allows two horses but without any regulations. They spoke in favor of the language change and felt that it would better control animals within the City.

Mayor Dafoe then declared the hearing adjourned at 6:55 p.m.
