Mayor Dafoe called the Public Hearing to order at 6:50 p.m. Karen Johnson, City Employee, acted as secretary. Mayor Dafoe stated that notice of the meeting time, place, and agenda was posted at the principal office of the governing body, located at 76 North 200 West, and was provided to the Millard County Chronicle/Progress, KNAK Radio, and to each member of the City Council, by personal delivery, at least two days prior to the meeting.

Mayor Dafoe explained that the purpose of the Public Hearing was to receive public comment regarding a proposed zone change from Residential Development (R-D) to Public/Quasi-Public (P/QP) on property located at 840 East Bristlecone Lane, and the adjacent property to the East of said property. The property is owned by Millard County and is located just East of, and includes, the Millard County Sheriff's Posse building.

The Planning & Zoning Commission has recommended that the City Council hold a Public Hearing for the purpose of receiving public comment regarding the proposed zone change and also recommends that the zone change be approved. The zone change would result in this property being zoned the same as the Fairgrounds and Ball Parks. Council Member Dale Roper asked if the Sheriff's Posse building would be included in the zone change and was advised that this property does include the Posse building.

Mayor Dafoe asked if there were any comments from the floor. There were no comments from the floor.
