

Mayor Dafoe called the Public Hearing to order at 6:45 p.m. Dorothy Jeffery, City Recorder, acted as secretary. Mayor Dafoe stated that notice of the meeting time, place, and agenda was posted at the principal office of the governing body, located at 76 North 200 West, and was provided to the Millard County Chronicle/Progress, KNAK Radio, and to each member of the City Council, by personal delivery, at least two days prior to the meeting.

Mayor Dafoe explained that the purpose of the Public Hearing was to receive public comment regarding a proposed amendment to the Fiscal Year 1996-97 Delta City Final Budget. The reason for the amendment is that two grants were recently received by the Library. One grant, in the amount of \$4,000, is to be used for a technology upgrade. Delta City will be expending \$5,500 in matching funds. The funds will be used to upgrade the Library computer system which is used for book check-out and computerized card catalog. The Library also received a grant, in the amount of \$10,000, to be used for purchase of non-fiction books such as biographies, and instruction books. This grant does not require matching funds.

Mayor Dafoe asked if there were any comments from the floor. The Council discussed the grants and matching funds. There were no other comments.

Mayor Dafoe declared the Public Hearing closed at 6:49 p.m.
