Mayor Dafoe stated that notice of the meeting time, place, and agenda was posted at the principal office of the governing body, located at 76 North 200 West, and was provided to the Millard County Chronicle/Progress, KNAK Radio, and to each member of the City Council, by personal delivery, at least two days prior to the meeting.


Mayor Dafoe explained that the purpose of the Public Hearing was to receive public comment regarding the proposed vacation of a 14-foot public utility easement, consisting of the West 7 feet of Lot 15 and the East 7 feet of Lot 14, White Sage Subdivision. The reason for the proposed vacation is that Lots 14 and 15 are being used as one building lot with the home located over the sight of the utility easement. The petition requesting vacation of the easement was received by the City Council and discussed at the Regular City Council Meeting held July 28, 1997. At that time, the matter was set for public hearing in order to receive public comment regarding the proposed vacation of the easement. All property owners in the White Sage Subdivision have signed in support of the petition.

Mayor Dafoe asked if there were any comments from the floor. There were no negative comments.

Mayor Dafoe declared the Public Hearing closed at 6:55 p.m.
