Mayor Bunker called the public hearing to order at 6:45 p.m. He stated that notice of the meeting time, place and agenda had been posted at the City Building, on the Utah Public Notice web site and had been provided to the Millard County Chronicle/Progress and to each member of the City Council at least two days prior to the meeting. City Recorder Gregory Schafer acted as secretary.

Mayor Bunker stated that the purpose of the public hearing was to receive public comment regarding a proposed Delta City Amended Budget for Fiscal Year 2009-2010. City Recorder Gregory Schafer explained that adoption of the amended budget is not required by Utah statute, but we like to prepare an amended budget at the end of the fiscal year in order to make certain revenue and expenditure appropriations more closely match actual revenues and expenditures for the year. The amended budget provides a clearer picture of actual figures rather than the proposed figures stated in the annual budget adopted prior to the start of each fiscal year. In addition, using actual figures for the year is helpful in establishing budget figures for the coming fiscal year.

City Recorder Schafer noted that the Delta City Amended Budget for Fiscal Year 2009-2010 totals \$3,850,607, with the general fund portion of the budget totaling \$2,280,945. This total is actually \$548,000 less than amounts appropriated in the budget adopted in June, 2009. Because of economic issues, all department heads reduced their expenditures, as directed by Mayor Bunker.
