Mayor Roper called the meeting to order at 7:00 p.m. He stated that notice of the meeting time, place, and agenda had been posted at the City Building, located at 76 North 200 West, had been provided to the Millard County Chronicle/Progress, to KNAK Radio, and to each member of the City Council at least two days prior to the meeting. Gregory Jay Schafer, City Recorder, acted as secretary.

Council Member Bruce Curtis offered an invocation, after which Mayor Roper led those in attendance in the Pledge of Allegiance.

MINUTES

The proposed minutes of a Public Hearing held September 10, 2001 were presented for consideration and approval. Following discussion, Council Member Gayle Bunker MOVED to approve the minutes of the Public Hearing held September 10, 2001, as presented. The motion was SECONDED by Council Member Bruce Curtis. Mayor Roper asked if there were any comments or questions regarding the motion. There being none, he called for a vote. The motion passed unanimously.

The proposed minutes of a Regular City Council Meeting held September 10, 2001 were presented for consideration and approval. Public Works Director Neil Forster noted that he attended the meeting, but is not shown in the minutes as being present. Council Member Glen Swalberg

MOVED to approve the minutes of the Regular City Council Meeting held September 10, 2001, as corrected. The motion was SECONDED by Council Member Gayle Bunker. Mayor Roper asked if there were any comments or questions regarding the motion. There being none, he called for a vote. The motion passed unanimously.

ACCOUNTS PAYABLE

The Council reviewed the accounts payable, a copy of which had been given to them two days prior to the meeting. Following discussion, Council Member Gayle Bunker MOVED to approve the accounts payable, in the amount of \$113,576.10. The motion was SECONDED by Council Member Robert Dekker.

UNFINISHED BUSINESS

MAYOR R. DALE ROPER: PROPOSED REPAIR & REPLACEMENT OF SIDEWALK ON 300 EAST STREET

Mayor Roper noted that each Council Member had a list showing the approximate length of frontage for each property owner on 300 East Street. Mayor Roper also noted that the proposed sidewalk is actually on 200 East Street, between 200 North and 300 North. Public Works Director Forster provided a cost estimate of \$8,560 for curb, \$2,916 for driveways, and \$6,400 for sidewalk, making a total cost of \$17,876 for the project. Mayor Roper recommended that, if the Council desires to replace the sidewalk, the project should be postponed until next spring so that funds could be budgeted for the project and, also, due to the fact that the concrete contractor has recently suffered the loss of one partner. Public Works Director Forster felt that it is too late in the year to begin this project.

Following discussion, Council Member Robert Dekker MOVED to put this proposed sidewalk repair and replacement project on hold until Spring, 2002, at which time the budget and cost of the project can be reevaluated and property owners can be contacted regarding participation in the project. The motion was SECONDED by Council Member Glen Swalberg. Mayor Roper asked if there were any comments or questions regarding the motion. There being none, he called for a vote. The motion passed unanimously.

NEW BUSINESS

MAYOR R. DALE ROPER: APPOINTMENT OF MUNICIPAL GENERAL ELECTION JUDGES

City Recorder Gregory Jay Schafer advised the Council that he has contacted several individuals who are willing to serve as election judges in the upcoming election and requested approval of the Council to appoint the following individuals as election judges:

The motion passed unanimously.


OTHER BUSINESS
