NEW BUSINESS

SHAWN HARRIS: PROPOSED HARRIS SUBDIVISION LOCATED AT APPROXIMATELY 450 NORTH 420 EAST

Shawn Harris reviewed his proposed subdivision located at approximately 450 North 420 East and requested Council approval.

Following review, Council Member Robert Banks MOVED to approve the Harris Subdivision, located at approximately 450 North 420 East, as proposed, with the condition that the road (450

North Street) along the north side of the subdivision be paved by the subdivider. The motion was SECONDED by Council Member Betty Jo Western. Mayor Bunker asked if there were any comments or questions regarding the motion. There being none, he called for a vote. The motion passed unanimously.

MAYOR GAYLE BUNKER: RESOLUTION NO. 06-308 ADOPTING THE DELTA CITY AMENDED BUDGET FOR FISCAL YEAR 2005-2006

A RESOLUTION AMENDING RESOLUTION 06-307 AND THE BUDGET ADOPTED THEREBY TO PROVIDE FOR AMENDMENTS TO THE FISCAL YEAR 2005-2006 BUDGET OF THE CITY OF DELTA, UTAH

Mayor Bunker stated that the Amended Budget for Fiscal Year 2005-2006 totals \$3,596,183.

A RESOLUTION ADOPTING A FINAL BUDGET FOR THE CITY OF DELTA, UTAH FOR THE FISCAL YEAR BEGINNING JULY 1, 2006

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Mayor Bunker reported that the Final Budget for Fiscal Year 2006-2007 totals \$4,225,487.

Following review, Council Member Bruce Curtis MOVED to adopt Resolution 06-309 adopting a final budget for the City of Delta, Utah for the fiscal year beginning July 1, 2006.
