

RESOLUTION NO. 84-107

A RESOLUTION ADOPTING A FINAL BUDGET FOR THE CITY OF DELTA, UTAH FOR THE FISCAL YEAR BEGINNING JULY 1, 1984.

The City Council of the City of Delta, Utah, referred to in this resolution as the "City Council," hereby recites the following as the basis for adopting this resolution:

A. Delta City is empowered and required to prepare and adopt a budget for each fiscal year under the requirements of Chapter 6 of Title ~~29~~⁴⁹, Utah Code Annotated (1953), as amended, referred to herein as the Uniform Fiscal Procedures Act.

B. The Uniform Fiscal Procedures Act requires that the Delta City budget be adopted by June 15 of each calendar year. The Act also requires that the budget include an estimate of property tax revenues anticipated by the City for the coming fiscal year based on assessment values provided by the Millard County Assessor.

C. The Millard County Assessor's office has been unable to provide the information necessary for the budget to be prepared by the June 15 deadline. The Delta City Manager has therefore obtained consent from the Utah State Auditor's office to extend the time within which the budget must be adopted.

D. Upon being informed of the inability of the Millard County Assessor to provide the needed information, the City Council directed that the tentative budget be prepared and filed with the City Recorder on June 21, 1984. The Council further directed that a public hearing regarding the tentative budget so adopted be set for July 2, 1984.

E. A tentative budget was filed with the City Council and City Recorder/Auditor on Thursday, June 21, 1984. A notice of the July 2 public hearing was also published on the same date.

F. The City Council conducted a public hearing on July 2, 1984, pursuant to notice as provided by law, at which public comment was received regarding the tentatively adopted budget for Fiscal Year 1984-85. Based on the tentative budget as approved by the Council and the modifications made thereto pursuant to the public hearing ~~held~~, the City Council has determined that said budget should be adopted by means of the resolution set out herein.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the City Council of the City of Delta, Utah:

1. Budget Adopted. The document attached hereto entitled "Delta City Fiscal Object Budget, Fiscal Year 1984-85"

is hereby adopted as the budget for the fiscal year commencing July 1, 1984. Such budget shall be subject to amendment as may be lawfully adopted hereafter by the City Council.

2. Administration. The City Manager, as the Delta City Budget Officer, is ordered to implement this budget in accordance with state laws and appropriate Delta City procedures, under the direction of the Mayor.

3. Effective Date. This resolution shall become effective upon adoption. The budget adopted hereby shall be effective for the fiscal year beginning July 1, 1984 and shall continue thereafter in effect, subject to lawful amendment by the City Council.

4. Filing. A certified copy of the budget adopted hereby shall be filed in the office of the City Recorder and shall be maintained there available for public inspection during regular business hours. The City Recorder is directed to file a copy of the final budget as adopted hereby with the Utah State Auditor within 30 days after the date of adoption.

5. Severability. In the event that any provision of this resolution less than the entire resolution is held invalid by a court of competent jurisdiction, this resolution shall be deemed severable and such finding of invalidity shall not affect the remaining portions of this resolution

6. Repeal of Conflicting Resolutions. To the extent that any resolutions, policies or procedures of the City of Delta conflict with the terms of this resolution, or the budget adopted hereby, this resolution and the terms of the budget adopted hereby shall be deemed controlling and such other conflicting resolutions, regulations or policies shall be deemed amended to comply herewith.
