

RESOLUTION NO. 98-252

A RESOLUTION TO DESIGNATE AN ENVIRONMENTAL CERTIFYING OFFICER  
FOR DELTA CITY, UTAH.

The City Council of the City of Delta, Utah, referred to in this resolution as the "City Council", hereby recites the following as the basis for adopting this resolution:

RECITALS

A. Delta City has applied for a grant for the expansion and renovation of the Delta City Library (hereinafter referred to as the "Project"); and

B. Delta City will be entering into a contract with the Utah Department of Community and Economic Development, Division of Community Development for said Project; and

C. Delta City is required to conduct an environmental review for the purpose of obtaining an environmental release prior to the commencement of the Project; and

D. An environmental certifying officer must be appointed to conduct the review.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the City Council of the City of Delta, Utah:

1. Designation of Environmental Certifying Officer. The City Council hereby designates and appoints the Delta City Mayor to serve as the Environmental Certifying Officer for Delta City, Utah.

2. Level of Authority. The Environmental Certifying Officer's authority shall be on a case-by-case basis for purposes of complying with certain federal or state grants or loans and the accompanying responsibilities associated therewith.

3. Effective Date. This resolution shall become effective upon adoption.


4. Severability. In the event that any provision of this resolution less than the entire resolution is held invalid by a court of competent jurisdiction, this resolution shall be deemed severable and such finding of invalidity shall not affect the remaining portions of this resolution.

5. Repeal of Conflicting Resolutions. To the extent that any resolution or policies of the City of Delta conflict with the provisions of this resolution, they are hereby amended to be in accordance with the provisions hereof.
