

RESOLUTION NO. 03-283

A RESOLUTION AMENDING SECTION 10 OF RESOLUTION 84-110 ENTITLED "LATE CHARGES" BY ESTABLISHING A NEW LATE CHARGE AND RECONNECTION FEE ON DELINQUENT AND/OR DISCONNECTED WATER SERVICE.

The City Council of the City of Delta, Utah, referred to herein as the "City Council," hereby recites the following as the basis for adopting this resolution:

RECITALS

A. On or about July 30, 1984, the City Council adopted Resolution 84-110 establishing, among other things, a procedure for imposing late charges in connection with water and sewer billing delinquencies and for disconnecting water and sewer services on delinquent accounts and imposing a fee for reconnecting said services.

B. The City Council has determined that the costs associated with providing or sending notices on delinquent accounts should be revised to reflect more accurately the current expenditures and costs associated therewith.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the City Council of the City of Delta, Utah:

Section 1. Resolution Amended. Section 10 of Resolution 84-110 adopted July 30, 1984, is hereby amended by deletion of the materials marked with an overstrike and by addition of the shaded material, to read, in its entirety, as follows:

"10. Late Charges. A late charge of \$4.00 ~~2.00~~ shall be charged to each water billing or sewer billing not paid by ~~within 30 days after~~ the due date shown on the billing statement. If the amount due on such water or sewer statement is not paid on or before the due date shown on said billing ~~within 60 days of the date shown on the~~ statement, the City of Delta, upon proper notice, may disconnect the water service and charge a reconnection fee of \$40.00 ~~\$25.00~~ prior to renewing service to the user responsible for payment of the delinquent account."

Section 2. Effective Date. This resolution shall become effective upon adoption.


Section 3. Severability. In the event that any provision of this resolution less than the entire resolution is held invalid by a court of competent jurisdiction, this resolution shall be deemed

severable and such finding of invalidity shall not affect the remaining portions of this resolution.

Section 4. Repeal of Conflicting Resolutions. To the extent that any ordinances, resolutions or policies of the City of Delta conflict with the provisions of this resolution, they are hereby amended to be in accordance with the provisions hereof.
