### WINTER PARKING

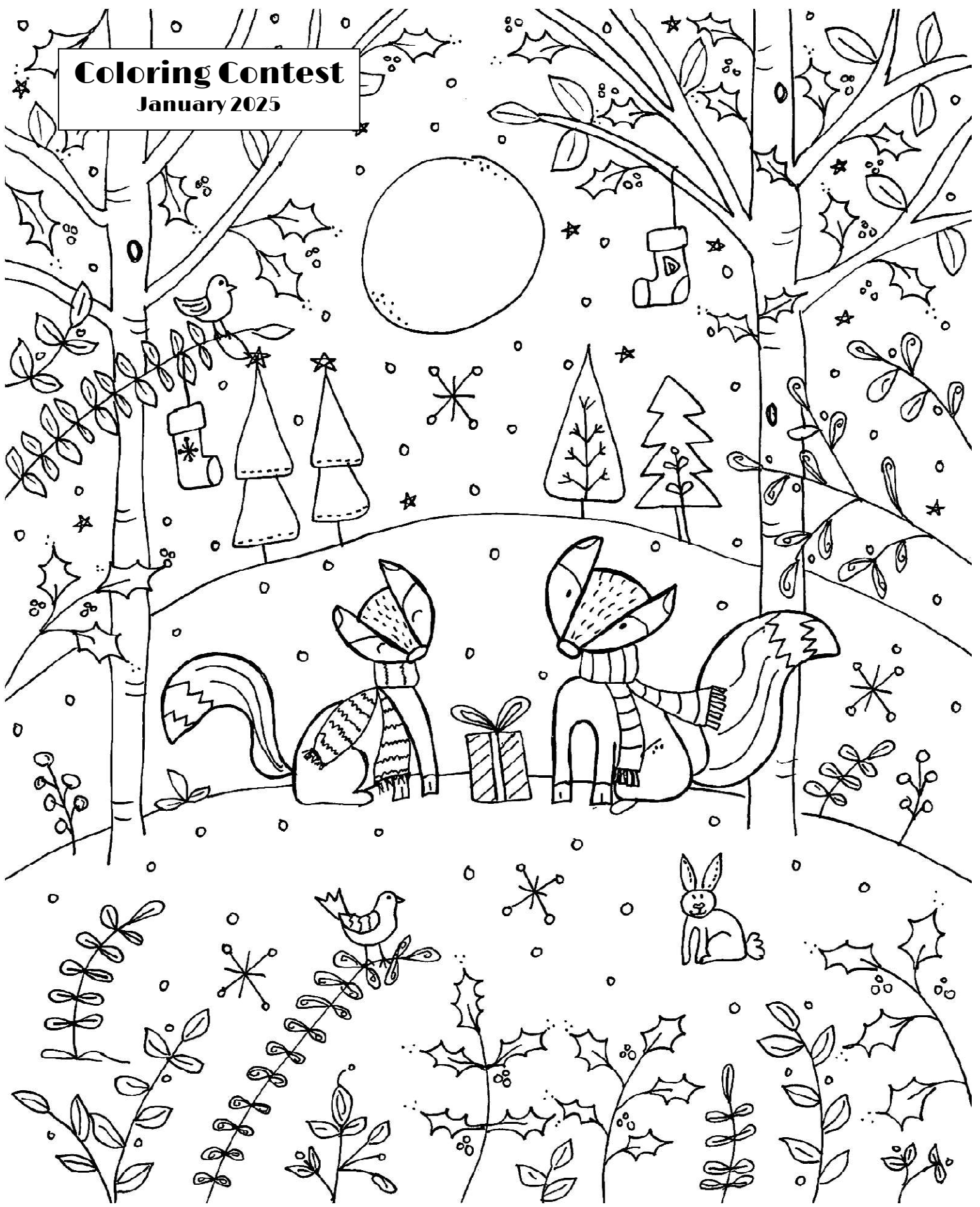
To allow for snow removal parking is not allowed on the City streets or paved rights-of-ways November 1<sup>st</sup> through March 31<sup>st</sup>.
