### GENERAL GARBAGE REMINDERS

As weather warms up, we receive neighbor complaints about weeds and garbage not being properly contained, being smelly and/or attracting cats, mice, and other critters. To help keep your neighbors happy as well as following City Code, please take care of your weeds and do not store garbage in your yard or in open vehicles. **See City Code online for details.**

Also, park dumpsters are for park use ONLY. We love when you clean up after your park outings, but please don't use them to clean out your house. Personal dumping is not allowed. You can haul it directly to the transfer station or contact a local hauling service.

### LANDFILL CHARGES

The landfill charge on the bill is a third-party charge for MILLARD COUNTY. We do not have any information on this charge. If you have any questions or concerns, you will need to contact them at 435-864-1400.

### CHICKEN PERMITS

A permit is required to have chickens within Delta City. Applications are available online and at the City Office. Note that roosters are not allowed.

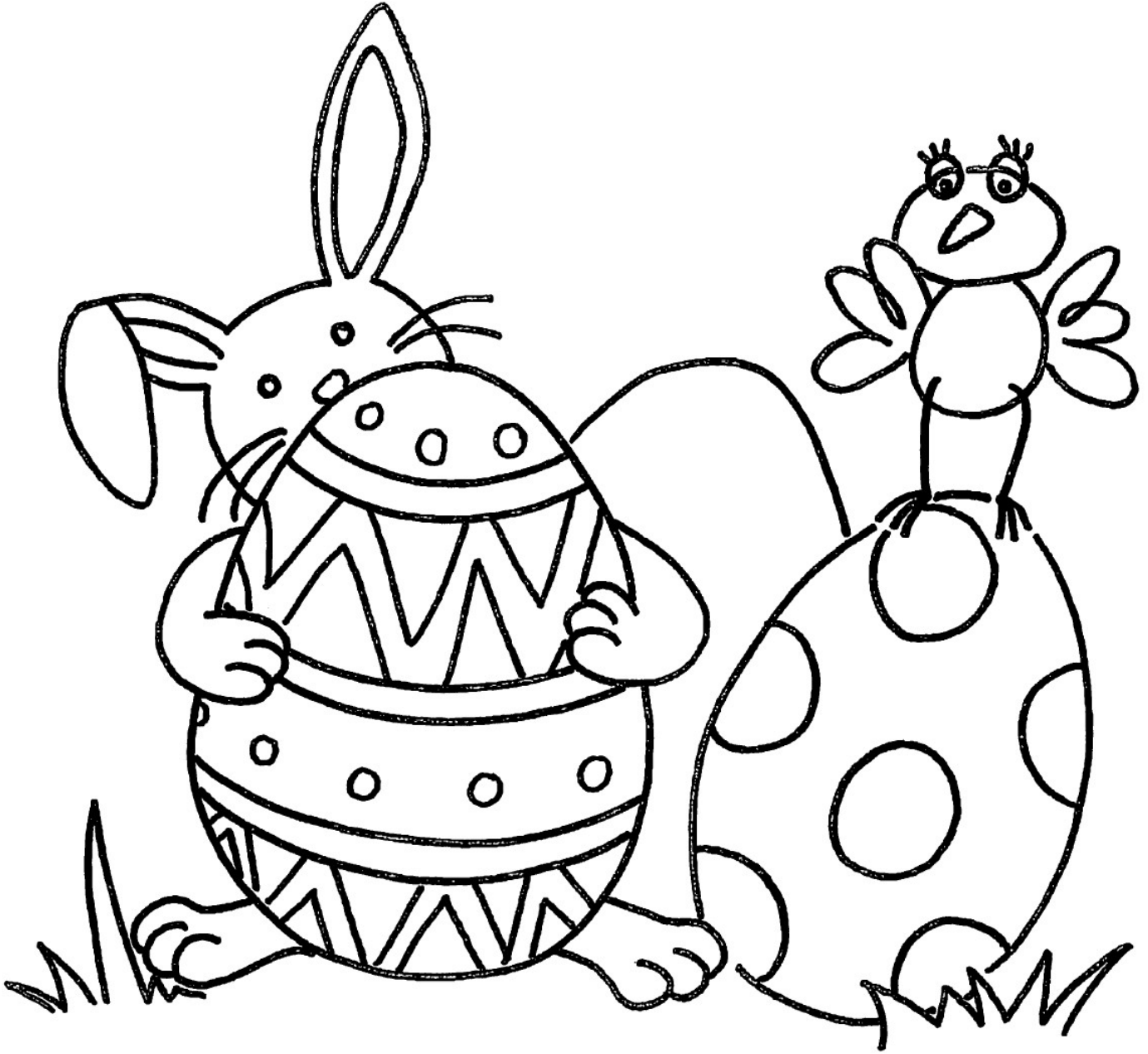
